How to change language on a motorola droid

Whether you accidentally selected the wrong language when you were setting up your phone, or purchased your device in a foreign country, you can easily change the language on your Android device by going into Settings. With more than 100 languages to choose from, you'll likely be able to find one that's suitable for you. Here's how to change the language on your Android device. Select your preferred language from the list by tapping on it. If prompted, select the region for your chosen language. Some languages offer an additional region-specific option. In such instances, after selecting your preferred language, you'll be brought to a new page with a list of regions to choose from. Select your preferred region by tapping on it. Christina Liao/Business Insider 7. Press firmly on the two horizontal lines to the right of your preferred language and drag it up to the first spot. Once your preferred language has been added, make it your Android's default language by pressing firmly on the two horizontal lines and moving it to the top. To change the language of the device and menus, follow these steps: From the Home screen, tap the Menu key. Tap Settings. Tap Language & input. Tap Language. Tap the language you want the phone to use. Click each step to see the action, click the picture or use the arrow keys You can have multiple languages saved to the phone but only one can be set as the default system language 1. Swipe down from the top of the screen with two fingers 3. Scroll down and tap System 7. Tap the language you wish to add 8. To reorder the priority of the languages, tap and hold on the four lines beside the language you wish to move 9. Drag it into position and then lift your finger: The language at the top of the order will be considered the default system language You can also ask questions directly to our community! How to change the language on Motorola Droid Turbo 2 What could be more annoying than someone enters the settings of your Motorola Droid Turbo 2 and "accidentally" changes the settings so that they are in a language unknown to you. Similarly, you can mistakenly do a factory restart with wrong language settings. For example, everything suddenly becomes Chinese, Arabic, Spanish or English. So we'll see here how to change the language on Motorola Droid Turbo 2. If you're using your Motorola Droid Turbo 2 smartphone, in most cases things will be fine if you follow this tutorial. Do not hesitate to contact an expert in case of difficulties, however! We'll see, the easiest way is to download a dedicated app to change the language settings, as available here. Change language via settings on Motorola Droid Turbo 2 So, without further ado, here's a step-by-step guide to how you can change your phone from one language to another. For starters, on every Motorola Droid Turbo 2, the menu for changing language is "Language and Keyboard". This "Language and keyboard" menu is always in the "Settings" main menu. Note that the "Settings" icon in the main menu always looks like a gear on the main screen of your Motorola Droid Turbo 2. Step 1: Visually locate and click on the "Settings for your Motorola Droid Turbo 2" icon. Normally, this is on the main page, or on the "All Apps" page, as shown below. Step 2: Select the "Languages & Keyboard" menu item under "Settings", which is the shape of the A key, just like on a computer keyboard. Step 3: Tap the first menu item under "Languages & Keyboard", which is usually "Select Language" on your Motorola Droid Turbo 2. Once you are there, you will see your own language and you can configure it by default. And that's it. In fact, as long as you can locate the "Settings" and "Languages & Keyboard" icons, you can always set your language. If you cannot change your keyboard, plenty of keyboard apps can help you to do so. Do not hesitate to seek the help of a friend or an expert of your Motorola Droid Turbo 2 if you can not do this change of language manipulation. To recap on the change of language on Motorola Droid Turbo 2: You can change the display language to Motorola Droid Turbo 2. The following information can help you define them yourself. The "locale" must be open, as described in the previous paragraphs. Then press the language already defined in the "Language" field From here you can select the new language you want Tap on the specific region in the list on your Motorola Droid Turbo 2 Finally, you have to press "Apply changes and restart" Installing a new language dictionary on Motorola Droid Turbo 2 First, you have to visit the main menu options on your Android Nexus tab. You will find an option with the label "Android keyboard". You must select this option, then the "Settings" icon next to this option. Now press the "Dictionary modules" option on your Motorola Droid Turbo 2. There you can see all other available language dictionaries that are supported by your device. You can select the desired language dictionary from among them. Finally, tap the "Install" option. Adding custom words in the dictionary on Motorola Droid Turbo 2 You must first launch the "Settings" application by tapping the corresponding icon on the home screen. Once you enter the settings, locate the "Language and keyboard" option and click on it. You can then press the "Personal Dictionary" from the list displayed on Motorola Droid Turbo 2. Touch the "Edit Personal Dictionary" option and then make changes to the dictionary. In the next step, press the plus symbol to display a text field on the screen. Enter the custom word you want to add to the dictionary and press the "OK" option. This word will then be added to the dictionary on your Motorola Droid Turbo 2 that can be used when entering messages or information later. Conclusion on adding custom words to the dictionary on Motorola Droid Turbo 2 To recap on adding custom words in the dictionary, go to Settings >> Language & Keyboard >> Personal Dictionary >> Edit Personal Dictionary >> Press '+' >> Enter Required Word >> OK. This will add the word of your choice in the dictionary of your Motorola Droid Turbo 2. It will be available to you by typing messages, if dictionary prediction is enabled. Install a translation application on Motorola Droid Turbo 2 You can also install an application to translate your pages from one language to another, as available here. The name of the application is a language translator. You can install this app from Google Play. You can also install Free Translate or Universal Translator to translate chats, documents and other formats on Motorola Droid Turbo 2. All these applications are normally free. You can use them without limits on the translation. Attention, the quality of the translation can vary strongly from one application to another or from one text translated to another. Estimated time: 5 minutes. 1- First step: First we go to the settings of the Motorola Droid Turbo 2, it is the icon of the cogwheel, it must be on the home screen or in the menu of the phone, you can access the main menu usually by dragging your finger from the bottom to the top of the screen. 2- Second step: We look for the System section, usually the icon of the exclamation mark symbol that is in the lower part of the screen. 3- Third step: Click on "Languages & input" it is the world globe icon. From this section you can change the language of the texts displayed on the Motorola Droid Turbo 2 and also the keyboard language. 4- Fourth step: Click again on "Languages", this is the first option at the top of the Motorola Droid Turbo 2 screen, usually with Chinese characters. 5- Fifth step: Press the + "Add a language" button to add a new language to the Motorola, a list of suggested languages will appear and below the rest of the languages. 6- Sixth step: Search for the language in the list or use the magnifying glass icon in the upper right to use the language search to find the language to which you want to change your Motorola Droid Turbo 2 and select it. 7- Seventh step: Once you have selected the language you want to install on your Motorola Droid Turbo 2 a list of options will appear to choose the region for that language, select the appropriate region. You must select the appropriate region to install the dictionary that corresponds to your country or geographical area. 8- Eighth step: Using the vertical lines on the right click and drag the language to the first position, this will be the main language of the Motorola Droid Turbo 2. Once the new language has been added to your Motorola Droid Turbo 2 you can delete the previous language that you will not use by following the link below: Delete language Motorola Droid Turbo 2
